The Managing Director, Kovai Medical Centre and Hospital Limited, Coimbatore has applied for establishment of a Medical College at Avinashi Road, Coimbatore. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Tamil Nadu have decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a new Medical College at Avinashi Road, Coimbatore in the name and style as "KMCH Institute of Health Sciences and Research", with an annual intake of 150 seats subject to the condition that a bank guarantee for a sum of Rs.350 lakhs for the establishment of teaching hospital to be handed over to the Medical Council of India, New Delhi and stability certificate of the hospital building obtained from the competent authority should be submitted to the Medical Council of India while making inspection and also rectification of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection Officers before the Medical Council of India inspection and the approval of Medical Council of India/ Government of India should be obtained.

- it is certified that:-
- a. The applicant owns and manages a 300 Bedded functional Hospital which was established in the campus of the proposed location.
- b. It is desirable and feasible to establish a Medical College in the Public interest
- c. Establishment of a medical college at Avinashi Road, Coimbatore District by Kovai Medical Centre and Hospital Limited is feasible.
- d. Adequate Clinical Material as per the Medical Council of India norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Medical College as per Medical Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.

The following shall be added in terms of Notification dated 31.01.2017 published in the Gazette of India:-

e. The Managing Director own and possesses 21.93 acres of land in Kalapatti East Village, Coimbatore North, Coimbatore District on which non-agricultural use of land is permitted and a Medical College / Hospital can be established on it.

- f. The building plan of the Hospital and Medical College has been approved by the competent authority, namely, the Commissioner of Town Country Planning, Chennai-02, designated by the State Government for such purposes on 11.12.2008 and 23.12.2010.
- g. The Hospital and Medical College have been granted Completion Certificate / Building Use Certificate by the competent authority, namely Executive Officer, Kalapatti Town Planning, Coimbatore, designated by the State Government for such purpose on 20.07.2011.
